**Eligible Entrants:**

Entry is only open to Australian residents who are 18 years and over and are a 2024 Member of the Essendon Football Club.

**How to Enter:**

To enter the promotion, the entrant must purchase, or already hold, an Essendon Football Club membership package in relation to the 2024 Toyota AFL Premiership Season or 2024-25 NAB AFLW Competition (excluding packages provided on a complimentary basis, Pet Memberships, Junior and youth Memberships, Digital International Memberships, Essendon Women's Network and Grand Final Guarantee 'add-ons', AFLW Contributions, Coleman Club, President's Club and Club 1872 packages) (**Eligible Membership Package**) during the Promotion Period.

**Further Terms and Conditions:**

Entries are deemed to be received at the time of receipt by the Promoter and not at the time of transmission or deposit by the entrant. Records of the Promoter and its agencies are final and conclusive as to the time of receipt.

3. 16. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to validate and check the authenticity of entries and entrant's details (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence). In the event that a winner cannot provide suitable proof as required by the Promoter to validate their entry, the winner will forfeit the prize in whole and no substitute will be offered. Incomplete, indecipherable, inaudible, incorrect and illegible entries, as applicable, will at the Promoter's discretion be deemed invalid and not eligible to win.
